The Means- through the blood of His cross

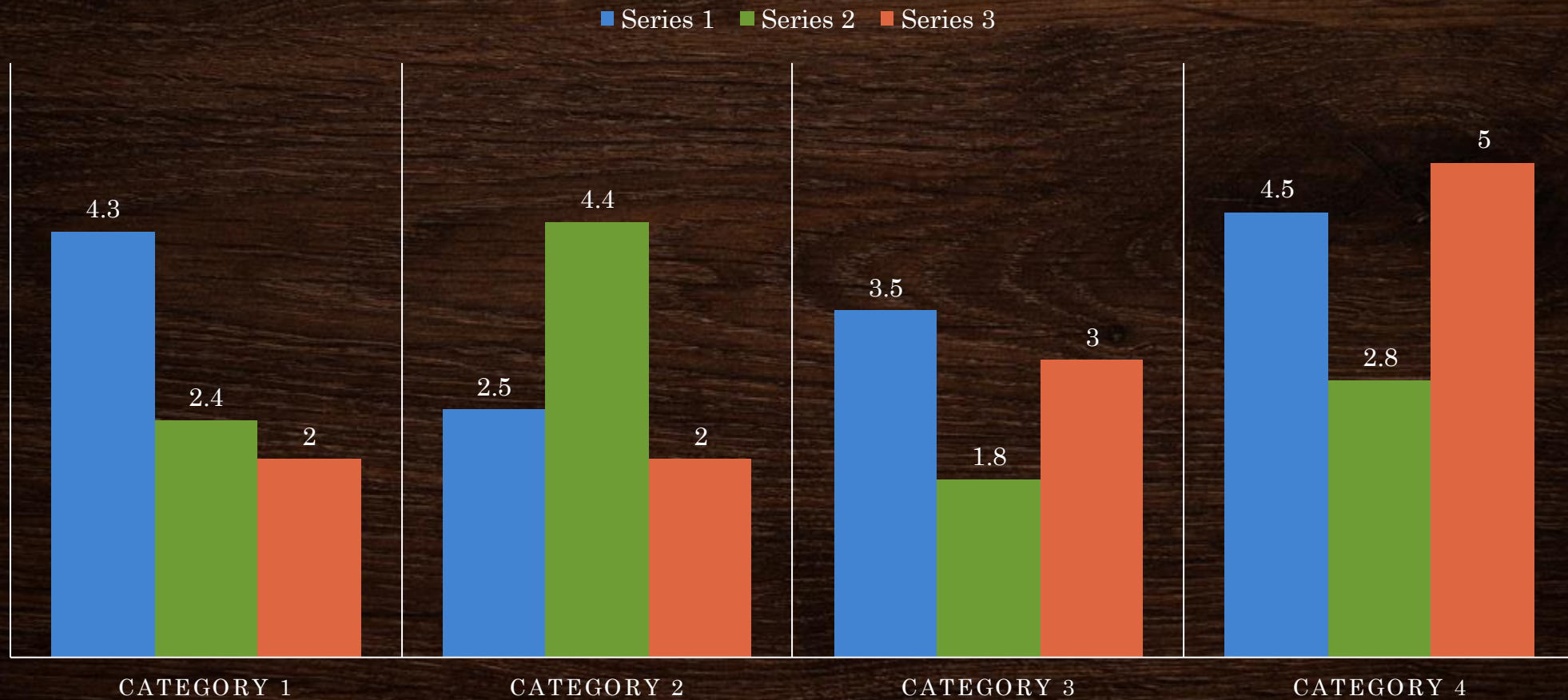
The Result- Peace between God and man

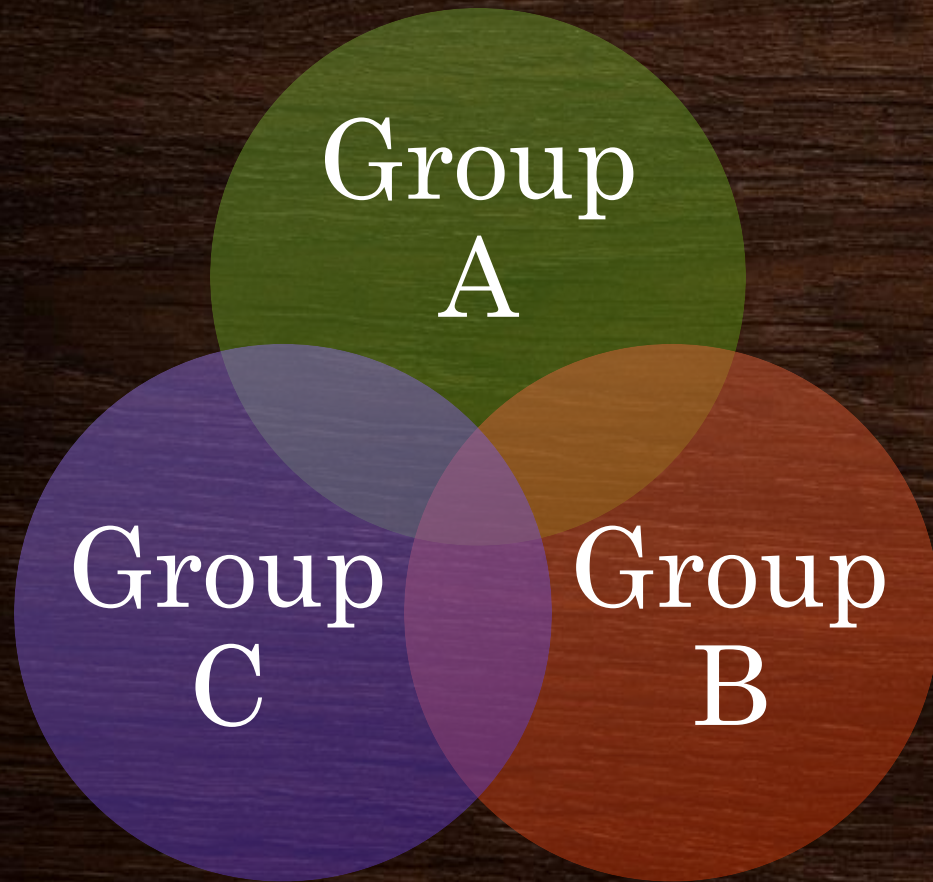

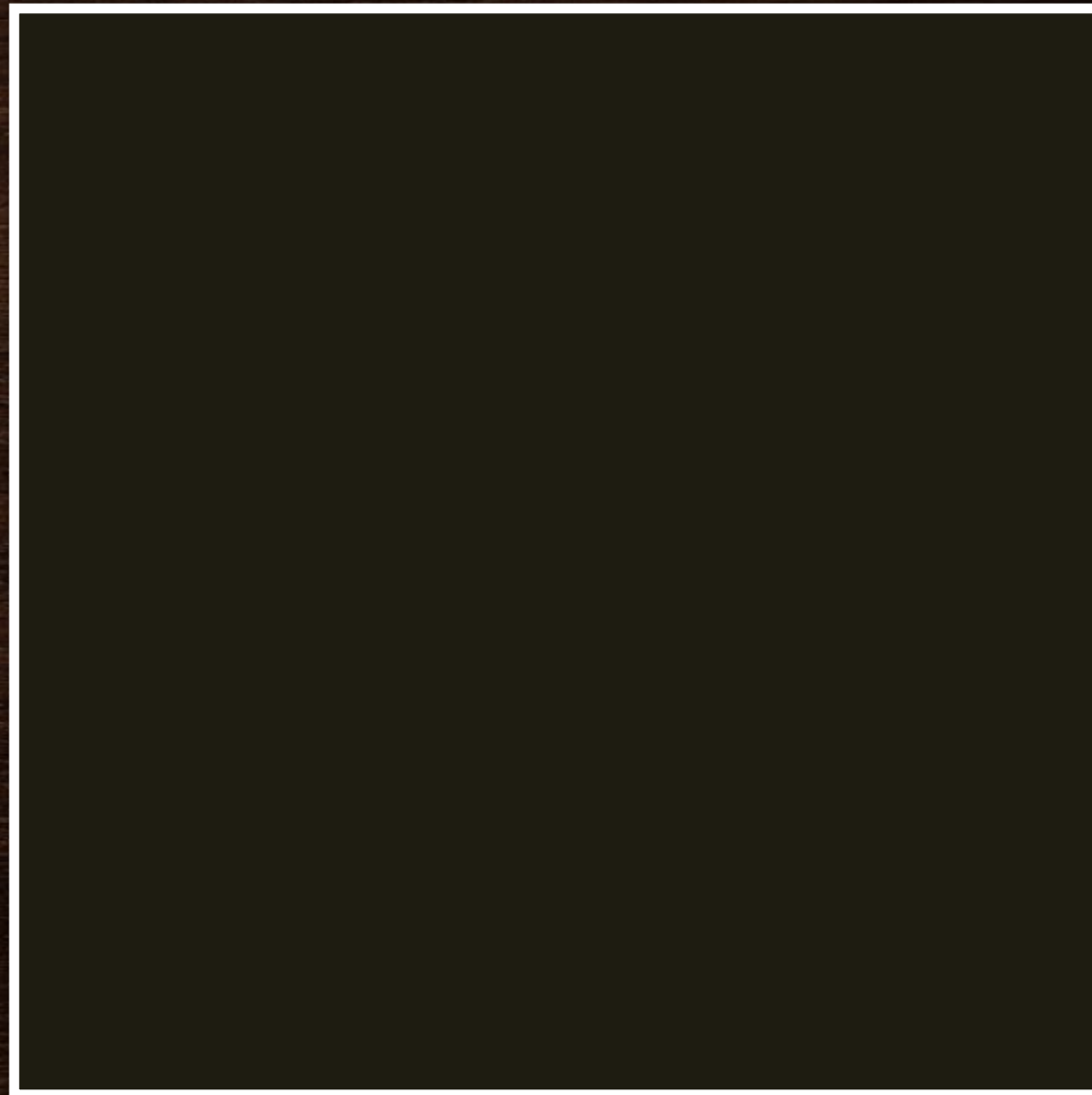
