The Belt of Truth

Symbolizes integrity and the foundation of God's Word in our lives. Truth empowers believers to stand firm against deception.

(Eph 4:15) Speak the truth in love

The Breastplate of Righteousness

Represents the righteousness of Christ, which guards our hearts against attacks of guilt and shame.

(Phil 3:9) Being found in Christ, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ

Shoes of the Gospel of Peace

Equips believers to stand firm and move forward with confidence in the message of reconciliation and peace through Christ.

The Shield of Faith

Faith in Christ is our greatest defense against the fiery darts of the enemy. It extinguishes lies, doubts, and temptations aimed at believers to make us ineffective in our marching orders.

The Helmet of Salvation

Protects the mind, ensures believers can be confident in their salvation and God's will.

Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

The Sword of the Spirit

The Word of God is the only offensive weapon in this armor. It allows believers to combat lies and temptations with scriptural truths.
