The Passover Table

Exodus 12

Eat it in haste; it is the LORD's Passover

Remembering the deliverance from
Egypt

V12-16 Preparation for Passover

Jesus sent His disciples (Luke 22:8, Peter and John) to prepare the Passover. It is important to obey His instructions, even when we don't understand all the details. The disciples followed Jesus' words and found exactly what He had told them.

Proverbs 3:5–6 “Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge Him and He will direct your path”

John 14:15 “If you love me, keep my commands.”

V17-21 The Betrayal: Heart Examination

“Is it I”?

This passage prompts self-reflection, confession, and repentance.

Psalm 139:23–24 “Search me, Oh God, and know my heart”

1 Corinthians 11:28 “Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup.”

Regular self-examination draws us closer to God and helps us address sin in our lives. Ask God to search your heart and reveal areas needing repentance?

V22-26 The Lord's Supper:

Remembering Christ's Sacrifice

1 Cor 11:24-25 When He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me. In the same way, after supper, He took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, when you drink it, in remembrance of Me

The Passover Meal

In remembrance of their deliverance
from bondage in Egypt.

The Lord's Supper

In remembrance of Jesus and our
deliverance from bondage of sin.

1) The First Cup – The Cup of Sanctification

“I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.”

2) The Second Cup — Cup of Deliverance

“I will deliver you from their bondage.”

3) The Third Cup — the Cup of Redemption

*“I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgment.” This cup is the new covenant in **My blood***

There is a 4th cup

The Fourth Cup — The Cup of Hope

'Then I will take you for My people, and I will be your God.'

The Marriage Feast of the Lamb

Revelation 19:6-9

Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, “Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure” for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.
