27-31 Jesus predicts Peter's denial  
27- You will all stumble (scandalon)

Zech 13:7 "Strike the shepherd and  
the sheep will be scattered"

Their shame of Jesus drove them  
away from Him

27-31 Jesus predicts Peter's denial

28- "But after I have been raised, I will go ahead of you"

Read: 1 Cor 15:12-23

29- Peter: "You're wrong about me."

Luke 22:31-32 “Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift all of you (plural) as wheat. <sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you (singular), Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers.”

30-31 Peter insistently denies Jesus

# Aspects of Brokenness

Surrender Over Self-Sufficiency: God breaks us to move us from being "self-made" to "God-made".

A "Broken Spirit" is Valued: Psalm 51:17 God does not despise a broken and contrite heart, but rather uses it as a sacrifice.

Scars as Qualifications: Painful experiences and past mistakes do not disqualify you; they become ministry tools and show God's grace

Refining Process: Just as bread was broken by Jesus to feed the multitudes, brokenness prepares us to be poured out for others.

Removing Obstacles: Brokenness can be God's intervention to detach us from destructive paths, pride, or ego.

Brokenness allows God to rebuild, redirect, and use a person fully for His purpose

# Gat Sheminim (Gethsemane)

V35- prayed His hour might pass by

John 2:4, 7:30, 8:20, 12:23-hour not yet

But now, His destined hour had arrived

**Mark 10:45:** "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many."

V36- Let this cup pass from Me

Psalm 75:8 In the hand of the Lord is a cup full of foaming wine mixed with spices; He pours it out, & all the wicked of the earth drink it down to its dregs

Isaiah 51:17 Awake, awake! Rise up, Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord the cup of his wrath, you who have drained to its dregs.

V37- Said to Peter, “Simon, are you asleep, could you not watch one hour”  
Luke 22:31 when you have turned back/  
broken from a former path

V38- The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak

Isaiah 53:3 He is despised  
and rejected by men, A Man  
of sorrows and acquainted with grief.

Isaiah 53:5 But He was pierced for our  
transgressions, He was bruised for our  
iniquities: the chastisement of our  
peace was upon Him; and by His  
stripes we are healed.

1 Cor 11:24-25 And when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of Me.

After the same manner, He took the cup, when He had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in My blood: this do you, as often as you drink this cup, in remembrance of Me
