- 6) Pilate

The Chief priest and others
“plotted to kill Jesus”

Mark 11:18, 14:1, Luke 19:47,
John 10:31....

“Are “you” the king of the Jews!

“It is as you say” - Jesus

Jesus gave revealed truth to Pilate and he rejected the Truth.

V5- if we reject truth, God will stop revealing more truth to us.

Please do not reject the truth of who Jesus Christ is.

V6-8 Tradition allowed a guilty
prisoner to be freed at a feast
Barabbas- son of a father

Jesus Barabbas

Jesus the Messiah

The crowd chose Jesus Barabbas

Sinful Barabbas (son of father) is received by the world.

Righteous Jesus (true Son of the Father) is rejected by the world.

Nothing has changed

2 Timothy 3:12 In fact, all those who want to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

1 Peter 5:10 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

V11-The chief priests stirred up people

V12- “What shall I do with Him who is called King of the Jews?”

V13- “Crucify Him”

V14- What has He done? “Crucify Him”

V15- Wishing to please the crowd...he turned over an innocent man to death.

John 18:28 Then the Jewish leaders took Jesus from Caiaphas to the palace of the Roman governor. By now, it was early morning, and to avoid ceremonial uncleanness, they did not enter the palace, because they wanted to be able to eat the Passover

V16-19 Ironic mocking

16- led to palace

17- clothed in royalty of purple

18- crown place on Jesus

19- Bowed and called Him King

20- Led Him out to be crucified

V21- Simon of Cyrene, father of Alexander and Rufus

Mark 8:34 "... pick up your cross and follow me..."

Romans 16:13: "Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother, who has been a mother to me, too."
