Job 14:12-14 So man lies down, and rises not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep. O that thou would hide me in the grave, that thou would keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou would appoint me a set time, and remember me! If a man die, shall he live again? All the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

V1- Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome brought spices to anoint the Lord. Their love for Jesus was mingled with despair.

Mark 14:3 While he was in Bethany, reclining at the table in the home of Simon the Leper, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, made of pure nard. She broke the jar and poured the perfume on his head.

2-Very early on the first day of the week

Acts 20:7 And on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached to them,

1 Cor 16:2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him

Rev 1:10 On the Lord's Day I was in the Spirit, and...

V3-4 “Who will roll the stone for us to enter for us to enter?”

They did not yet understand

Our Father, has acted to remove obstacles so that we may come to Him
Salvation is a plan initiated by God.

V5-6 Angel says do not fear/amazed
“He has been raised”

Psalm 16:10 Because you will not abandon me to the realm of the dead, nor will you let your faithful one see decay.

1 Corinthians 6:14: "God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power".

Romans 8:11: "...He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you".

1 Cor 15:3-4 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance:

1) Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that

2) He was buried, and

3) that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures

V7-8 Angels tell them to go and **tell others**. This is still the job of disciples.

What we find at the cross and at the grave is weak disciples.

But God doesn't stop there.

We also find strong grace

2 Corinthians 12:9 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.

We must roll stones away so that people may come to Christ.

When was the last time people saw a stone rolled away?

Do you remember the story of Lazarus?

Do you remember what Jesus said to them?

John 11:39 “Only believe and you will see the glory of God”

Matthew 28:8-9 So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly, Jesus met them, “Greetings” He said. They came to him, clasped His feet and worshiped Him. Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me.”
