# The Lord and the Pharisees

2:18 We do not like that you eat

2:24 We do not like when you eat

2:28 Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath

# The Pharisees

3:1 Waiting to accuse

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness but denying its power.

Pride in self-righteousness hates grace.

V6- Desired to kill Jesus.

## John 6:26-27 / The Crowds

“Truly I say unto you, you are looking for Me, not because you saw the signs I performed but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you.”

Crowds- acknowledge Jesus for physical needs and (v9) restrict/crowd Jesus

The Called- acknowledge Jesus as Lord and look to serve Him.

Demons- acknowledge Jesus as Son of God, but reject His authority.

# The Called

V9- the “crowds” crowded/restricted Jesus

Jesus appoints whom He Himself wants

He sends them to preach the gospel

He gives them authority to do the work

Obedience to law

Is fulfilled in  
Christ, worldwide, and Church age
