Jesus is Lunatic, Liar, or Lord

Mark 1-Following Jesus requires
sacrificial service

Mark 2- Opposition must be met
with boldness and determination

Mark 3- True disciples seek Jesus,
learn from Him, and do His will

Trilemma- a situation in which a choice has to be made among three possible alternatives.

What is the right choice of:
“is Jesus a lunatic, a liar, or The Lord?”

V21- His family believed “Jesus has lost His senses”

V22- The scribes believed Jesus was possessed

V23- He called “them” to Himself and began to teach them in parables

V23-27 Satan's kingdom will fall
from one who is stronger.

Gen 3:15- He will crush your head.

1 John 3:8 Jesus was revealed to
destroy the work of the devil

The Unpardonable Sin

John 16:8-9

⁸ When the Holy Spirit comes, he will convict the world of sin and of righteousness and of judgment.

⁹ about sin, because people do not believe in Me;

John 16:10-11

¹⁰ of righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; ¹¹ and of judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

John 16:13
