Psalm 19:1-6

V1- The heavens declare the glory of
The Lord.

The expanse declares the work of His
hands

The size of the universe is estimated to be at least 93 billion light-years across, and it may be infinite. The observable universe is 95 billion light-years in diameter, filled with trillions of galaxies, each containing billions of stars.

The Sun traveling at 514,000 mph takes 250 million years to circle Milky Way.

Romans 1:19-20 Since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

Romans 10:17-18

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. ¹⁸ But I ask: Did they not hear? Of course they did: “Their voice has gone out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world.”

V2-6 The Sun glorifies God, and it speaks day after day, and the utterance has gone through all the earth, and to the end of the world.

Psalm 14:1/Psalm 53:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God.

So all mankind is without excuse.

Psalm 113:3 From the rising of the sun to the place where it sets, the name of the LORD is to be praised.

God speaks to us through His Word

Psalm 19:7-11

If you want to hear God speak to you, then read His Word.

Nature shows God's general revelation
But salvation requires salvation
revelation.

Nature teaches us there is a god.

Salvation revelation tells us His name.

V7-9 The law (God's word) of The Lord
First time God's name is used.

V7-11 Tells us The LORD wrote down
His word to us.

The Bible isn't nature's word; it isn't
man's word;

The Bible is God's Word.

Isaiah 55:10-11

Matthew 5:18 For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished

Isaiah 40:8 The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever.”

V7-11 Tells us The LORD wrote down
His word to us.

The Bible isn't nature's word; it isn't
man's word;

The Bible is God's Word.

Isaiah 55:10-11

V10-God's Word is sweeter than honey

Psalm 34:8 Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in Him.

Louis Braille- blind at 3

Explosion and a man learned braille with his tongue

God speaks to us through His Spirit

Psalm 19:12-14

V12a- who can discern error

V12b- acquit me of hidden faults

V13- keep me from presumptuous sins

God can save you from sin ruling over you.

Jude 1:24 “Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you unblemished in His glorious presence, with great joy.”

God keeps us when we can't even keep ourselves.

Because God can keep us from sin and from ourselves, we can be righteous and blameless and acquitted of great transgression.

The goal of Psalm 19?

V14- Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in Your sight...

O LORD,
my Rock, my Redeemer
Hundreds of years before Jesus
was born in a manger, David knew
the Lord was His Redeemer.
Jesus is your Redeemer
Praise the name of The Lord!
