V8 – God's grace to die for sinners

God sent His Son to pay our debt

The Results

V9- Justified by His Blood

Saved from wrath through Jesus

V10- Reconciled thru death of Jesus

Saved thru life of Jesus

V11- Rejoice in God thru Jesus

V12-14 The Reign of Death

Universal death means universal sin

V13- Why did people die prior to the 10 commandments?

V14-Adam's children were of the same nature as Adam: Born into sin

Gen 1:26 "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness.

Gen 5:3 When Adam had lived 130 years, he had a son in his own likeness, in his own image; and he named him Seth.

1 Cor 15:20-22 Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. ²² For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.

Adam's sin brings death
Christ's righteousness brings life

-Adam is the representative for all who sin

-Christ is the representative for all who believe

V15-17 God's Grace outshines our sin

God's one gift leads to justification

V18-21 “So then...” (return from v12)
