

Romans 6:1-14

Deliver us from evil

Romans 1- God has revealed Himself to us

Romans 1- Humanity has rejected God

Romans 2- God is just, and God is impartial

Romans 3- Every human is guilty of sin

Romans 3- God's grace covers our sin

Romans 4- Justification comes by faith

Romans 5- Results of justification

V1-7 Dead to Sin, but Alive to God

V1-2 Grace Justification is not to be used to continue in a lifestyle of sin

V3 God declares us as having died on the cross with Christ.

V4 We are also declared to having been raised with Christ

V4b- The purpose of our resurrection, is so that we may “walk in newness of life”

V5- Because we are united in His death, we are united in His rising

V6-7 And we “know” that we were crucified with Christ

John 11:43-44

When Jesus had said these things, He cried with a loud voice,

“Lazarus, come forth!”

And Lazarus, who had died, came out bound hand and foot with grave clothes, and his face was wrapped. Jesus said to them, “Loose him, and let him go.”

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

(The dead are free of penalty.)

V8-11 Dead to power of sin. But now
living to God

V9- Christ rose from the dead and the
penalty of sin has no hold over us

Death is no longer applied to those
justified by God's grace.

The goal of God's grace is not to allow
us to continue in sin.

The goal of God's grace is to deliver
us from sin.

Lord's prayer: "Deliver us from evil"

Isaiah 25:8 He will swallow up death forever. The Sovereign LORD will wipe away the tears from all faces

1 Cor 15:54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, & the mortal with immortality, then the written saying will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

V12-14 Dead to reign of sin

As sin brings spiritual death and we have been raised to eternal spiritual life, we should no longer continue in sin as it no longer can control us.

The power of sin has been broken.

Revelation 21:4

And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away.”
